

Action Plan 2021-2022

- Review the effectiveness of the new music curriculum on coverage through our school music progression – seek CPD / Music Hub support in areas weakest covered and make any changes based on coverage. Continue to review developments in music schemes such as Sing up and Charanga as well as the benefits of following the MMC - [On-going throughout year- changes made by July to implement in September 2022 – Pupil interviews to take place at start and end of the year.](#)
- Improve the music displays in the classroom to showcase music – Refer to them during lessons regularly and allow children to track music listened to and studied throughout a term. - [Displays to launch in September and effectiveness reviewed in Spring term](#)
- Include a listening section within each lesson using music by our composer of the month, something they will study later, repertoire from around the world or music listed on the Model Music Curriculum listening list. – [Implement from September and review effectiveness at stages throughout the year](#)
- Music to return to pre covid levels including assemblies and after school choirs and clubs when appropriate guidance suggests it is safe to do so. [Look at starting with limited numbers in the Autumn term in preparation for Christmas events.](#)
- Last year's action plan point of singing leaders to be implemented this year. [Discussions in early September as to suitable candidates with staff – Aim for sessions to start in after October half term](#)
- Continue to improve school music resources – suggestions for this year are extension leads for Keyboards / Headphones and splitters for Music Tech work on Ipads and Laptops / replacement of aging percussion instruments. [Ongoing throughout year within budget constraints](#)
